Classes Offered:

Ballet, Ballet/Tumble, Pointe, Contemporary, Modern

Tuition and Fees:

Our school year season is divided into two 17-week semesters. Students participating in Semester 2 will be eligible to participate in the annual Recital.

Semester 1 begins September 18, 2023. Payments for Semester 1 may be paid in full or in 3 installments due 9/15, 10/15 and 11/15.

Semester 2 begins February 8, 2024. Payments for Semester 2 may be paid in full or in 3 installments due 2/15, 3/15 and 4/15. Students participating in the annual Recital will have costume payments due by 2/1.

If you only select classes from East Bay Ballet Arts, tuition is listed next to each class description. If you take these classes in combination with other dance classes at RSDE, tuition will follow the Young Dancer, Core Dancer, or Main Dancer programs. EBBA offers classes for students focused on Ballet. If you are looking for other options or dance styles please visit our website for more information.

Discounts: If you pay both semesters 1 + 2 by September 15th you will receive a 5% off discount. To receive the annual discount, you must contact the office to have it applied. Families with 2 or more dancers receive an automatic 10% off discount on each semester.





Class Details:

Ballet: A classical dance form emphasizing grace and precision along with formalized steps and gestures set in intricate, flowing patterns to create expression through movement. This class will perform 1 routine in the annual Recital and have 1 costume. Costume fee will be \$65 (First Steps/Discover Dance Divisions), \$75 (Primary/Classic/Main Dancer Divisions) and include all accessories. Pointe students must also take Ballet and will wear the same costume in the Recital. Pointe students must have a teacher recommendation to enroll.

Ballet/Tumble Combination: Students will be introduced to the basics and fundamentals of Ballet with an emphasis on developing gross motor skills, muscle control, musicality and spatial awareness. Students will also learn basic tumbling skills while focusing on flexibility and balance. Basic skills such as flowers and forward rolls are introduced. This class will perform 1 routine in the annual Recital and have 1 costume. Costume fee will be \$65 and include all accessories.

Modern: A free and expressive style of dancing that began as a reaction to classical ballet. It employs a special technique for developing the use of the entire body and implements abstract ideas. This class will perform 1 routine in the annual Recital and may wear a black leotard and/or black shorts/leggings. Accessory fee will be \$35.

Contemporary: A style of expressive dance that combines elements of modern, jazz, lyrical and classical ballet. Dancers strive to connect the mind and the body through fluid dance movements. This class will perform 1 routine in the annual Recital and may wear a black leotard and/or black shorts/leggings. Accessory fee will be \$35.
